■ Foreign Currency Exchange

■ Passport and Visa Requirements

Visitors from PRC may apply for individual travel plan (free-go-about) with travel agencies of several major cities in Mainland. Visitors so engaged will be allowed 15 days of traveling, including partaking in conference in Taiwan. Others may require special exit and entry permits to come to Taiwan.
